MEMBERSHIP COMPLIANCE FORM : Year 200

CONDITION OF MEMBERSHIP FOR BOTTLERS

In applying for, or renewing a bottler membership, and as a condition precedent to membership, I hereby voluntarily acknowledge, agree and consent to :

1. Each of my company's bottling plants meet the sanitation and quality standards of bottlers membership as adopted by ABWA and as may be modified by its Executive Board from time to time.
2. To allow each of my company's bottling plants to be inspected annually by an independent inspection agency approved by ABWA for the purpose of determining whether said plant(s) meet the minimum ABWA sanitation and quality standards.
3. For any plant whose initial annual inspection indicates that it fails to meet said sanitation and quality standards of bottler membership to demonstrate compliance, at my company's expense, through a re-inspection or other suitable means if determined by ABWA to be necessary; said re-inspection or other means of demonstrating compliance to occur within a reasonable period of time (determined by the Executive Board) of notice from ABWA that said plant does not meet the standards of membership.
4. That final approval of my application or renewal for bottler membership and continuation of said membership thereafter from year to year shall be contingent on : (a) allowing the annual plant inspection and any re-inspection or other appropriate follow-up means of demonstrating compliance determined to be necessary by ABWA, as required; (b) obtaining and maintaining thereafter the necessary passing score for said inspection or any necessary re-inspection in accordance with ABWA standards of bottler membership, and; (c) compliance with all ABWA standards.
5. Until first plant inspection is passed, I understand that my company will be listed as a Candidate Bottler and will not be able to use the ABWA logo until such time.
6. It is understood that the continuous maintenance of the quality standards of the standards of the product remains the responsibility of the member, during production and in the market. The Association is not responsible for a member's faulty products in the market.

DESCRIPTION ON MEMBERSHIP CATEGORIES:

International Candidate Bottler : A Candidate Bottler shall be defined as a company which bottles or packages water which is in the process of obtaining mandatory product certification through officially appointed bodies to become a Bottler Member.

International Bottler : A Bottler shall be defined as a company which bottles or packages water in compliance with international standards, has obtained the mandatory product certification, through officially appointed bodies, has a Certified Plant Operator in its plant(s).

International Supplier : A Supplier Member shall be defined as a Company which is engaged in the rental or sale of equipment, products, supplies or services to the bottled water industry for its domestic and overseas markets.

International Distributor : An International Distributor Member shall be defined as a company which does not bottle water and which is the distributor of an ABWA Bottler Member or a Bottler Member of other associated association.

International Affiliate : The Affiliate Section has been created for companies exploring the possibility of entering into the bottled water industry. This category is intended solely for the purpose of assisting potential bottlers, allowing them a means of gathering information and progressing into Candidate Bottler Member or Bottler Member.
